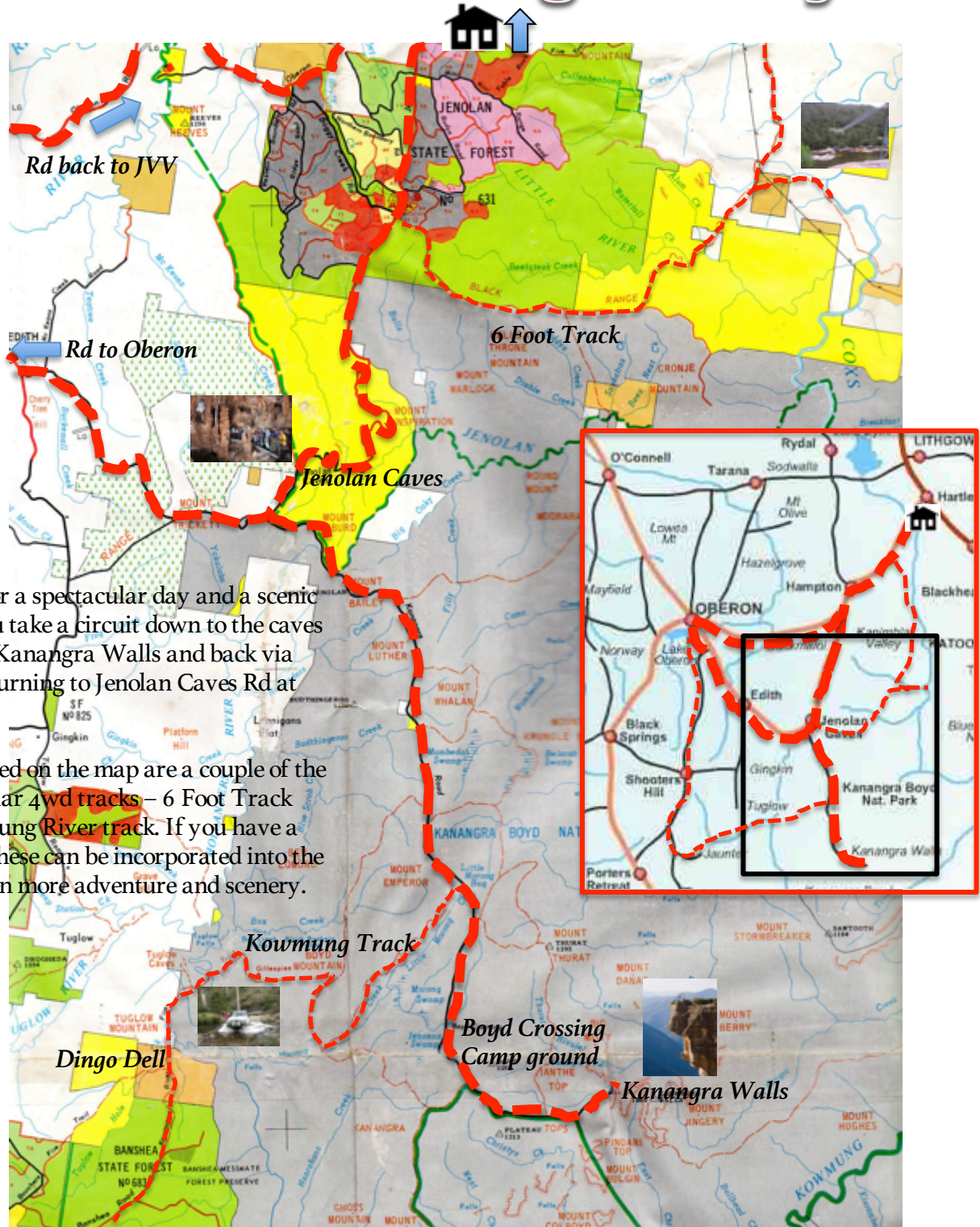


# Jenolan / Kanangra Day Trip



It makes for a spectacular day and a scenic drive if you take a circuit down to the caves then on to Kanangra Walls and back via Oberon returning to Jenolan Caves Rd at Hampton.

Also included on the map are a couple of the more popular 4wd tracks – 6 Foot Track and Kowmung River track. If you have a 4wd then these can be incorporated into the day for even more adventure and scenery.



## Jenolan Caves

- turn left onto Jenolan Caves Rd at the top of Maxwell Dr
- follow Jenolan Caves Rd all the way down to the caves
- most people like the River Cave
- there is a good picnic area down at the caves – free bbq's
- 30 mins drive from JVV





### **Kanangra Walls**

- continue on same road to the caves out the other side of the valley about 10 kms to the T intersection
- turn left and follow road to the end, carpark and picnic shelter
- follow the walking track down to the lookout
- there is a track to the right just before the lookouts that leads out onto the walls where you can get a photo like the one above
- 30 mins drive from caves to Kanangra Walls, 1 hr return walk out onto the walls

### **Kowmung River Fire Trail – 4wd**

- track leaves on right about 12kms after turning onto Kanangra Rd
- fire trail is clearly sign posted
- a popular and fairly easy track
- care needed in wet weather
- lovely picnic spot at Dingo Dell
- about a 2hr trip back to the sealed road



### **6 foot track – 4wd**

- turn left off Jenolan Caves Rd about 6 kms towards the caves on Lowther Siding Rd
- follow the valley to the end and join the track that leads to the 6 foot track
- turn left and follow track to the Cox's river
- there is a good picnic area with toilets down at the river, the kids can paddle
- follow the track back all the way to Jenolan Caves rd
