Evans Crown and Tarana pub Afternoon

If you are keen to do a bit of a hike up to one of the districts least known but most impressive lookouts then a great afternoon can be had at Evans Crown.

The walk is about 30 mins up hill along a reasonably well formed track with a bit of a scramble at the end. Make sure that you get right to the top as the view is 360 degrees from Bathurst in the west to the mountains in the east.

You pass by Lake Lyell driving over the dam wall. You can visit Rydal Pub and the historic Rydal train station on the way.

A great finish to the afternoon can be had at the historic Tarana Pub where there is a terrific outdoor beer garden in Summer and an open fire in Winter – pub meals available, milkshakes for the tin lids
